

101 on Copying files to a blank CD

Step 1

Place a BLANK CD in your CD-Writer

Wait a bit for Windows to belch and burp

Below window should eventually show up

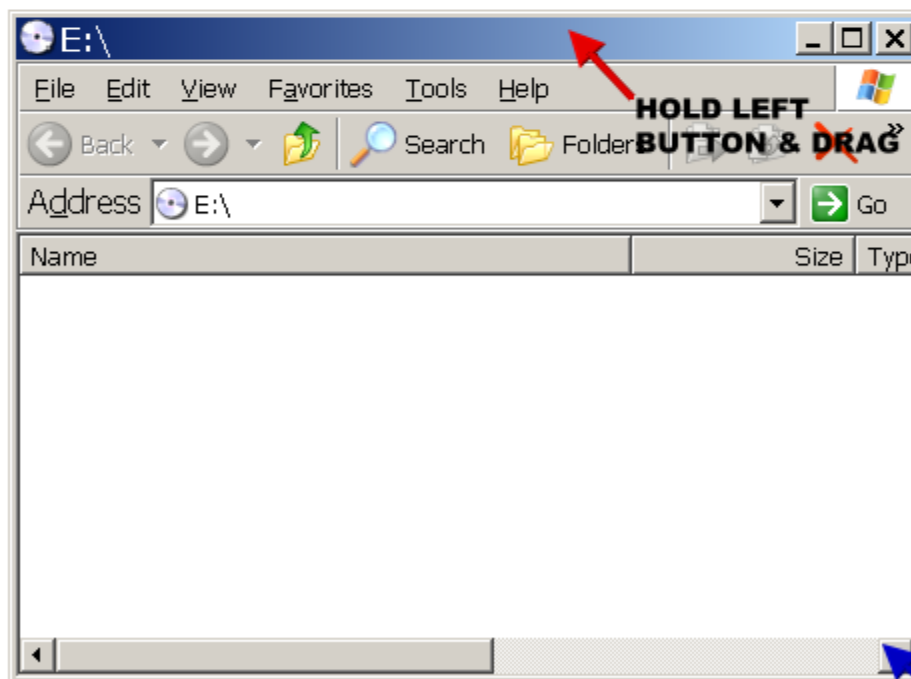
It should have most of the programs on your computer for burning blank CD's listed
choose the one you want to use.

For this Demo I'm going to choose "Open writable CD folder using Windows Explorer"



Step 2

Below window should show up after clicking OK above



If above Window takes up your whole screen. Left click mouse on the two box's just left of the X at top right of screen. Make this window some what small by placing cursor on bottom corner until double arrow shows up and resize. then Holding down on Left mouse button in blue bar drag window to bottom right of screen.



Make Window Smaller

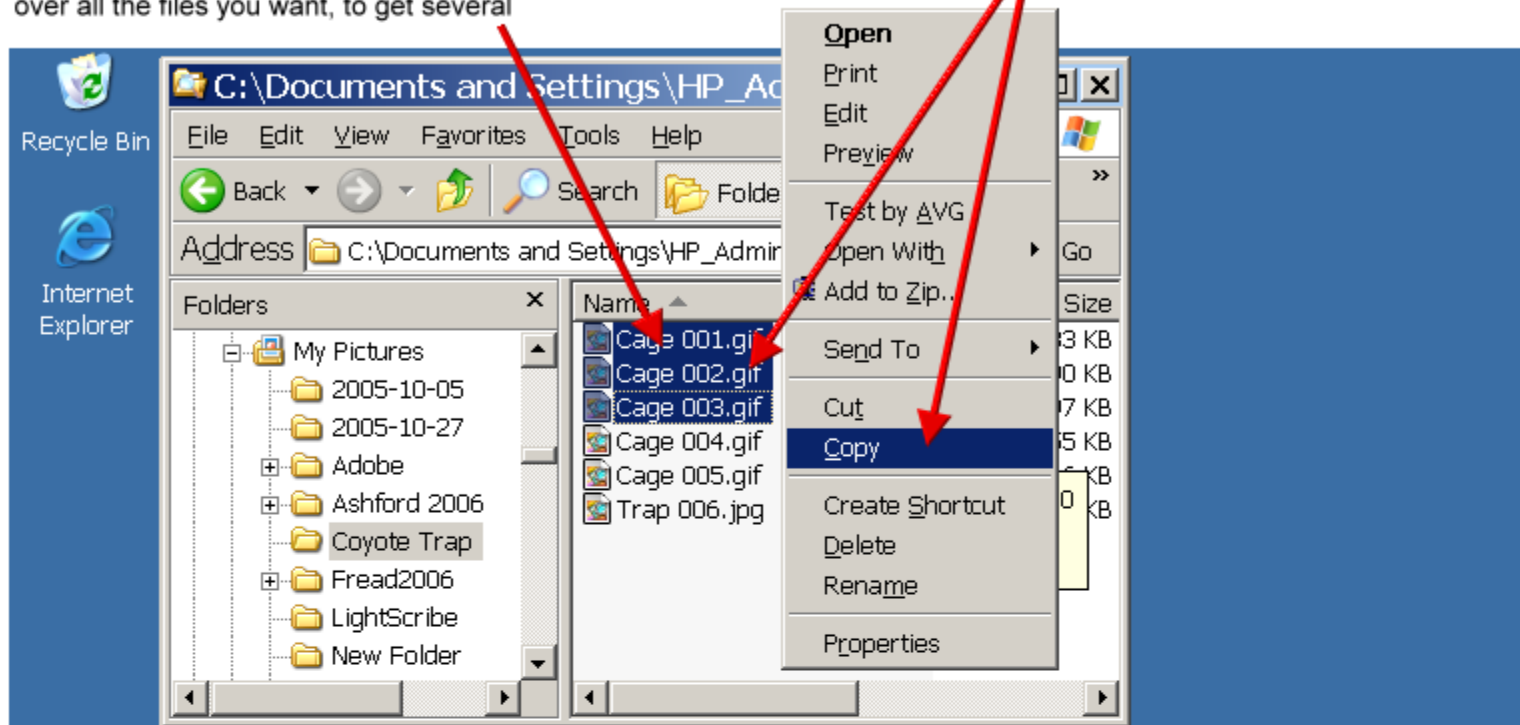
Stay with me here, steps are scattered around on this page. Find Step 3, then 4 and 5 and so on.

Step 4

Highlight files you want to copy by left clicking mouse on them
TIP start by HOLDING down on left button just to right of file name and dragging over all the files you want, to get several

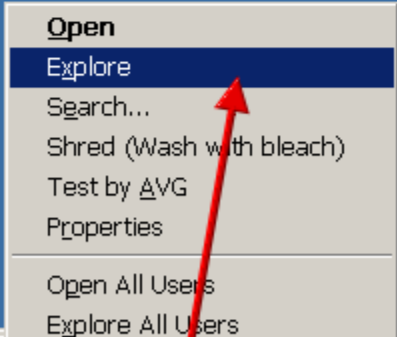
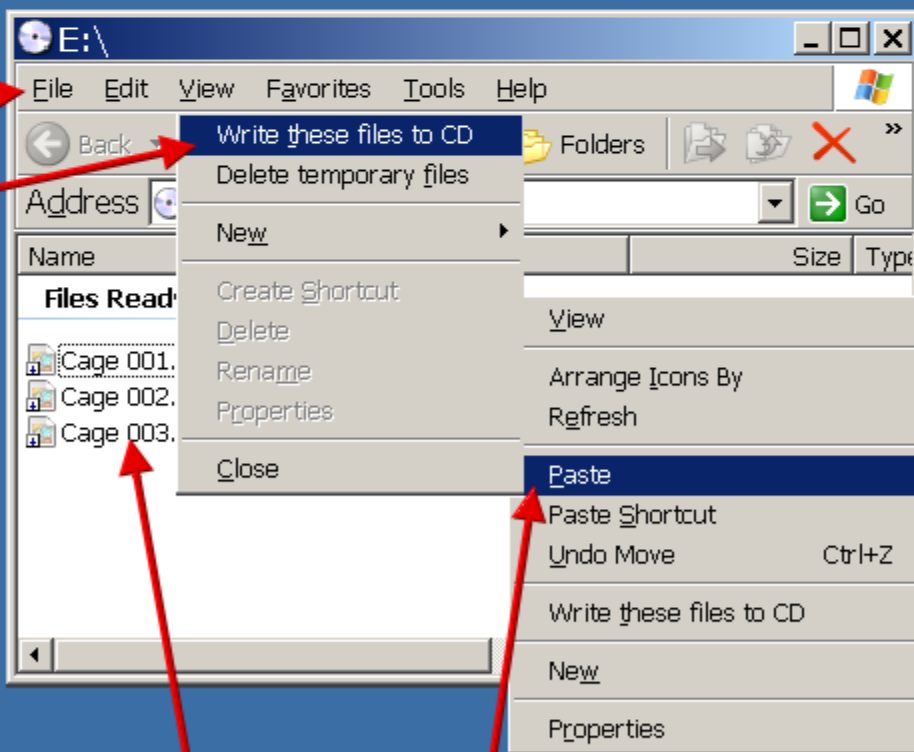
Step 5

RIGHT click on HIGHLIGHTED files then select Copy from window



Step 7

Left Click "File"
Then Select "Write these files to CD"



Step 3

RIGHT Click on START
Then LEFT click on "Explore"

RIGHT Click on BLANK CD folder you want
to Copy to and select "Paste"
